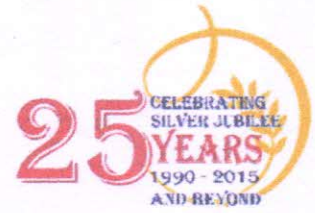

Instructions for students:-

- All students should refer to Maharashtra state guidelines with regards to RTPCR test before travelling to Maharashtra.
