#### Speaker – Dr. Savita Nilakhe

Topic - Overcoming of Sanskrit fear and its application in Ayurveda texts.

- Students overcame their fear of Sanskrit and learned to apply the language effectively while reading and understanding Ayurvedic texts.
- Madam explained the salient features of Sanskrit, including important elements such as *visarga* and *anusvāra*, helping students gain clarity in pronunciation and usage.
- She also introduced the rules of *visarga* and provided a basic introduction to *vibhakti*, enabling students to recognize and apply these concepts during textual study.




## > Report 5- Sanksrit Drama

➤ Under the Vadatu Sanskritam initiative, the Department of Samhita Siddhant and Sanskritam successfully conducted a

two-hour cultural and academic event titled "Bhārati Guṇavatānam Vidyāpeetha" on

- > Time -from 10:00 a.m. to 12:00 p.m.,
- ➤ Venue- PG Lecture Hall, Ground Floor, New Building.
- The entire programme was presented in Sanskrit, including anchoring and dramatic performances. Students showcased thought-provoking dramas on contemporary themes such as "Mobile: A Boon or Bane," "Ayurveda vs. Allopathy," and "The Importance of Sanskrit in Ayurveda." Additionally, Sanskrit renditions of Bollywood songs and popular advertisements added creativity and enthusiasm to the event.
- ➤ The programme was judged by Dr. Santosh Chavan and Dr. Swati Gadgil, and prizes were awarded by Dr. Manasi Deshpande and Dr. Madhuri Pawar.
- 🕨 1st drama आयुर्वेदः श्रेयस्करः (Ayurveda is better than Allopathy)
- ➤ The drama featured three patients who initially visited an allopathic doctor but were misguided in their treatment.
- Later, an **Ayurvedic physician correctly guided the patients**, providing them with appropriate medicines, a suitable diet plan, and essential lifestyle modifications.
- Through this, the drama highlighted the effectiveness and holistic approach of Ayurveda in restoring health.






- > 2<sup>nd</sup> drama -भवन्तः न्यायालयः (Court room drama- Mobile boon or bane)
- ➤ The drama featured **one judge, two lawyers, and four witnesses** debating the topic "Mobile Boon or Bane?"
- ➤ It highlighted issues like kids' addiction to reels, youth losing focus due to gaming, and parents feeling helpless.
- ➤ At the same time, it showed mobiles as a **strong tool for communication** and education.
- ➤ The judge concluded that mobile phones are neither boon nor bane—everything depends on the user and their self-control.





- 🔪 3<sup>rd</sup> drama संस्कृतस्य महिमा (Greatness of Sanskrit language)
- ➤ This drama was a discussion between students, where they comically highlighted how certain Sanskrit verses are often misinterpreted and then presented their correct meanings in an engaging and humorous way.
- ➤ The comic style kept the audience engaged while also **educating them about the importance of correct interpretation** of classical Sanskrit texts, especially in the context of Ayurveda.
